Free Camping at the park, No hook ups or dump station on grounds, self contained units only!

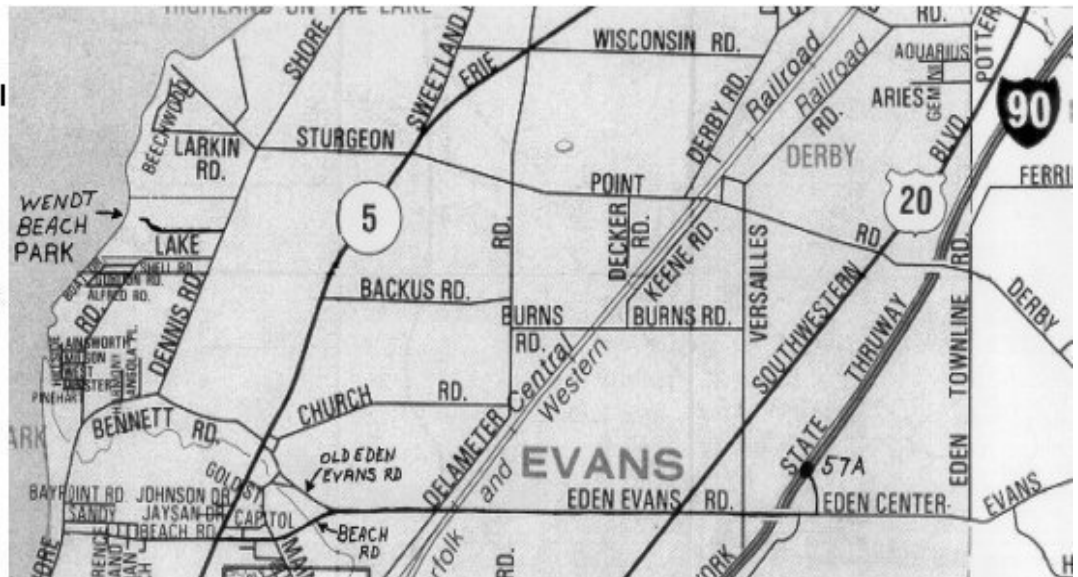

Exit 57A off I-90 and turn right. Cross route 20, cross RR tracks, the road name will change shortly to Beach Rd., keep going until you get to route 5. Turn right and go to the first light (6/10 mi.) and turn left. This is Bennett Rd., follow to Dennis Rd. and turn right 1 mile to Hunt Site.

From Buffalo take route 5 to Sturgeon Point Rd., and turn right, then go to Old Lake Shore Rd. and turn left. 1/4 mile to Hunt Site.

## Hunt Rules

**\*\*\* HEADPHONES ARE REQUIRED DURING ALL HUNTS \*\*\***

**\*\*\* NO Pulse Detectors Allowed \*\*\***

**All hunt fields will remain off-limits at all times other than scheduled hunts until the last hunt is completed on Sunday.**

1. Metal Detecting **IS** allowed in the park only for the 2 days that we are holding our hunt. Please stay clear of others using the park that are not there for detecting, so all can have a fun day.
2. Before being allowed on the hunt field, all entrants must clearly display their entry badge. No Exceptions. Anyone not registered to hunt will not be allowed on the field. The only exception is if you are registered as a hunt partner. (A hunt partner is a helper that will retrieve a target for the hunter with a physical disability that can hunt but cannot bend over to the ground to retrieve the target and fill in the hole. The hunter may not leave the hunt partner and continue hunting until the hunt partner has retrieved the target and filled in the hole.
3. Digging tools are limited to a knife, small trowel, screwdriver or probe. No claw type tools allowed.
4. All targets are shallow, and there is no need to dig large holes. FILL IN ANY AND ALL HOLES as neatly as possible.
5. Finder should remove any trash on or in the hunt fields.
6. Hunt Marshals will enforce the rules, and can evict repeat offenders. No refund will be given to anyone evicted from the hunt.
7. Prize tokens are redeemable at the tent immediately after the hunt in which they were found.
